Kemerovo State Medical University invites you to take part in the **I International Scientific and Practical Conference “Through thorns to the stars: space exploration”**, dedicated to the 60th anniversary of the First Soviet Cosmonaut Team, which will be held on **April 13, 2020** in Kemerovo.

**The conference will organize the work of the following sections:**

1. Man and the cosmos: from myth to reality.
2. From the history of space research.
3. Space medicine.
4. International Cosmonautics Day.

Students, undergraduate students, graduate students, teachers, local historians, museum workers can participate in the conference.

Scientific works should be presented in texts of up to 3 full pages: sheet of format A 4, font Times New Roman 14. Fields: left 2.5 cm, right, top, bottom - 1.5 cm each. Alignment in width, line spacing 1 The transfer is automatic.

The first line - AUTHORS - CAPITAL, centered;

2nd line - CAPITAL TITLE, **BOLD TYPE**, centered;

3rd line - organization - lowercase, *italic type*, centered;

After 3 lines, there is a space. Then the abstract with a red line is printed, the indentation is 1.25 cm. The annotation volume is 3 lines. With a new line - no more than 5 words. ***Title, full name of authors, resume and keywords are duplicated in English!***

For students, undergraduate students and graduate students indicate the degree, academic rank, initials and surname of the supervisor (see sample). The work of students, undergraduates and graduate students must be signed by the supervisor.

The text of the abstract should be divided into the following sections:

**Purpose of the study**

**Materials and research methods**

**Results and its discussion**

**Conclusions**

**It is necessary** to provide a list of sources and / or literature of at least 2, but not more than 4 items. Abstracts should contain references to the indicated sources and / or literature.

Electronic version of the abstract in format doc. or docs., a completed registration card (to be filled out for each co-author) and a scanned copy of the abstract signed by the supervisor should be sent **no later than April 05, 2020** to the email address: [konfimed@kemsma.ru](mailto:konfimed@kemsma.ru) with the section name and surname of the first author. Registration card and materials should be presented in the form of attached files. The name of the file is the name of the author (first co-author). For example, Ivanov S.P. No more than 2 texts are accepted from one author (co-author)! Publication of materials is free. A collection of abstracts will be sent for posting in the E-library with indexing at the RSCI.

**Works sent later than the deadline, executed not according to the rules, not corresponding to the topic of the conference are not published and are not returned. Reviewing work is performed. The originality of the submitted text should be at least 70%.**
